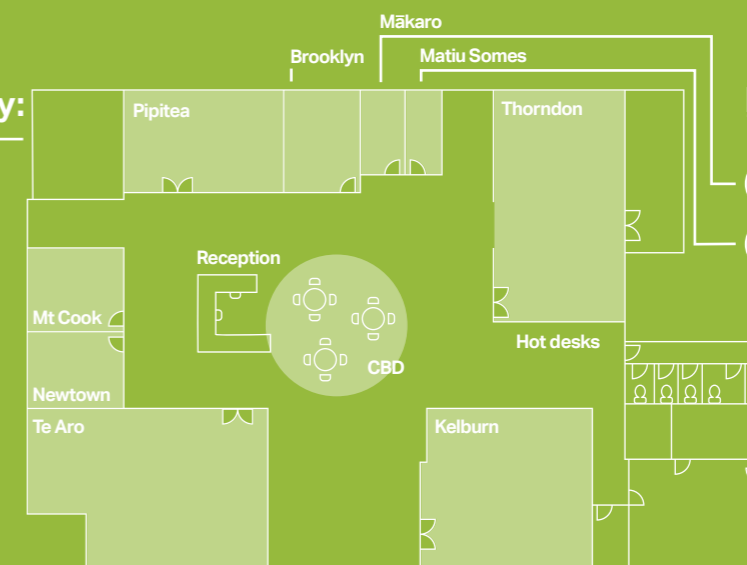



Wellington Tips

Front+Centre

When you visit Front+Centre, you've arrived in the heart of Wellington. We're surrounded by a number of comfortable and affordable places to stay and some of the best cafés and restaurants in the country. Here are our top Wellington recommendations.

WHERE TO STAY

Distinction Wellington Century City Hotel, 70 Tory St

Directly across the road from Front+Centre, the hotel features 1, 2 and 3 bedroom apartments which come with free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, kitchenettes and balconies. NB: the Distinction Hotel offers a subsidised rate for government clients.



QT Museum Wellington, 90 Cable St

Opposite Te Papa and a 10 minute walk from Front+Centre, this quirky boutique hotel features rooms with 42-inch flat-screen TVs, free Wi-Fi and iPod docks, as well as Nespresso coffeemakers.



Copthorne Hotel Wellington, 100 Oriental Parade

Across the street from Wellington Harbour, this hotel has refined rooms and comes with Wi-Fi (fee), flat-screen TVs with satellite channels, and minibars. The rooms also include 24-hour room service, and balconies with city views; upgraded rooms overlook the harbour.



QT Quality Hotel, 223 Cuba St

This vibrant, chic hotel has modern rooms with free Wi-Fi, flat-screen TVs, sitting areas, and tea and coffeemaking facilities. Airy apartments have kitchens, and some have whirlpool tubs.



HOW TO GET HERE

Getting to and from the airport

Front+Centre is an easy 15 minute drive from the airport. You can either take a taxi from the airport or hop on the bus – the Airport Flyer.



Airport Flyer

The Airport Flyer is an express bus service that travels between the CBD & Wellington International Airport. The fare costs \$9.00 one way – pay with cash or your Snapper card. The flyer drops passengers off on Courtenay Place, just around the corner from Front+Centre.



PARKING

CARE Park, 70 Tory St

Next to the Distinction Wellington Century City Hotel and directly opposite Front+Centre is some of the cheapest parking in the capital. Early bird parking (park before 10am) for only \$12.00 a day.

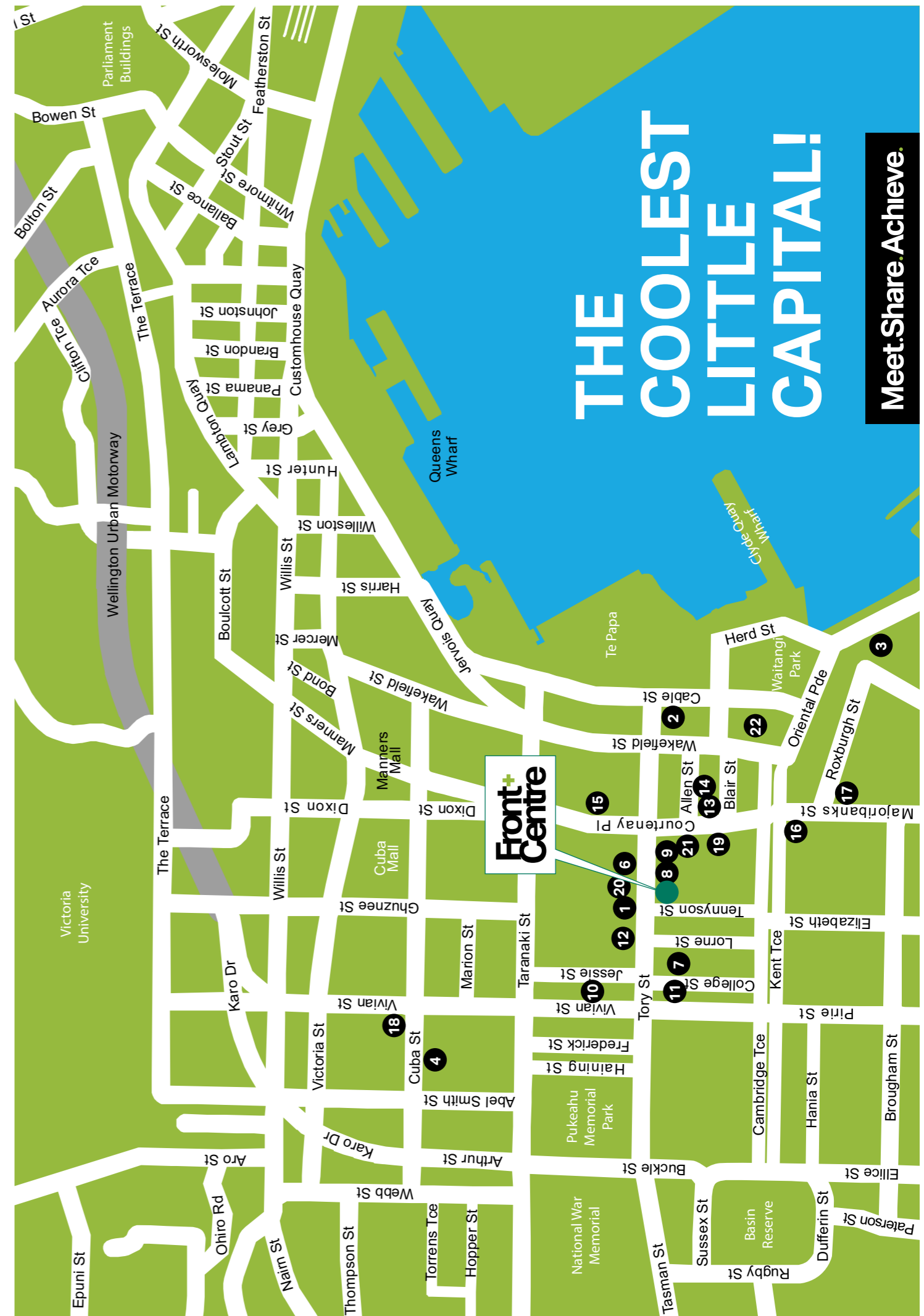
